**RE: THE ENGINEERS (SCALE OF FEES FOR PROFESSIONAL
ENGINEERING SERVICES) RULES, 2022.**

Pursuant to Section 58 (d) of the Engineers act, 2011, and the Statutory Instruments Act 2013, the Engineers Board of Kenya in collaboration with the stakeholders, developed the Engineers (Scale of Fees for Professional Engineering Services) Rules, 2022. The Rules prescribe the standards and conditions of professional practice for persons registered and licensed under the Act. The Rules were gazetted on 18th May, 2022 through Legal Notice No.20 of 2022.

The purpose of the Rules are to: -

- i. Ensure the provision of quality professional engineering services. This would effectively anchor the safety and welfare of the public. Further, it would enhance of socio-economic development of the Country in the realization of the National Developmental Agenda such as Vision 2030, Africa Agenda 2063 and the SDGs.
- ii. Be used as a guide and to prescribe the minimum fees chargeable by professional engineers for professional engineering services

- iii. Prevent undercutting by and among professional engineers who offer professional engineering services
- iv. Lay a framework for engineers within which to provide technically feasible, economically viable and sustainable engineering solutions in an ethical and professionally accountable manner. They would in return receive reasonable compensation for the professional engineering services offered.

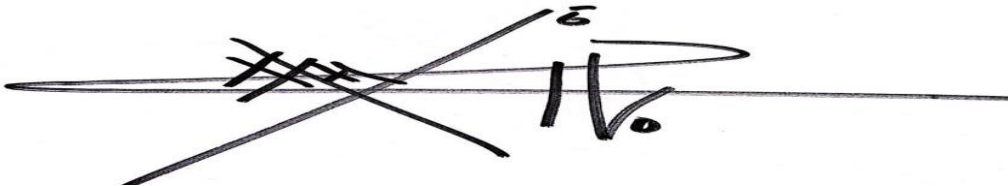
The Board now brings to the attention of all consumers of professional engineering services, the approving authorities and the Ministries, departments, including Heads of State Corporations, Semi-Autonomous Government Agencies (SAGAs) and other institutions that **from 15th August, 2022**, the Engineers Rules 2022 (Scale of Fees are now effected. The Scales of Fees shall apply in all engagements with professional engineers regarding the provision of professional engineering services.

Kindly take note that Part IV Section 23(4) of the Rules stipulates that the fees for the professional engineering services shall be set on a written agreement between the consumers of professional engineering services, i.e., the client and the professional engineer or engineering consulting firm that is offering the services.

Also please note that these Engineers Rules 2022 supersede all the previous Scale of Fees issued by the then Ministry of Public Works (1987) and by any other institution or agency.
