The **Engineers Board of Kenya (EBK)** is a statutory body established under Section 3(1) of the Engineers Act, 2011. The Board is responsible for the registration of engineers and engineering firms, regulation of engineering professional services, setting of standards, development and general practice of engineering.

One of the functions of the Board under the Engineers Act, 2011 section 7 (1) (q) is to 'Plan, arrange, coordinate and oversee continuing professional training and development and facilitate internship of graduate engineers. The Engineers Board of Kenya has developed Graduate Engineers Internship Program (GEIP) which is a structured internship program for graduate engineers that is designed to enable them to acquire requisite hands-on skills and prepare them for professional practice in their respective engineering fields.

The program will run for 24 months and the graduate trainees will be trained under professional engineers who are registered by the Board.

The Board will provide monthly stipend to graduate trainees as per the Public Service Commission Guidelines. In line with its functions, the Board is seeking for placement opportunities for the graduate engineers under the Graduate Engineers Internship Program (GEIP) in various disciplines within the engineering sector.

Some of the incentives that organizations will receive by signing up for the program will be:

- Onboarding graduate engineers employed in the partner organization into GEIP program for purposes of mentorship towards professional registration.
- Professional Development Units (PDUs) for engineers who will be enlisted as mentors/supervisors.
- Publishing of names of industry, providers and mentors on website and annual reports
- Certificate of commendation to the organization
